Armand Roux & Cie was founded in 1842 by Mr Armand Roux with a business partner Hendrik van der Voort. At the beginning, the company is a « generalist négociant » selling wines from Bordeaux, Burgundy and the Loire Valley. Now, the Armand Roux oenologist work with local wine growers to produce a range of Bordeaux wine.

The winemakers at Armand Roux become more involved with our partner growers at the early stages of the supply process, monitoring and advising on quality. The growers have been chosen on the potential of their terroir and the quality of their wines.

VINEYARD

The Bordeaux vineyard spreads across more than 110 000 hectares. Its position on the 45th parallel, facing the ocean, makes it unique in the world.

Thanks to the large variety of its soils made up of gravel, rich sand, clay resting on chalk, the terrain is extremely rich.
